## Instructions for Squaric Acid Immunotherapy for Warts

- Apply with a dropper a small amount to <u>ONE</u> wart <u>ONCE A DAY</u> until mild irritation (redness and itching) develops. This is like "liquid poison oak" so do not get the medication on other parts of your body.
- 2) Once mild irritation occurs, start applying to <u>3-4 warts</u> at a frequency just enough to maintain a mild reaction for 2-3 months (sometimes, just once or twice a week is enough to maintain the mild irritation).
- 3) The biggest risk is: severe allergic reaction all over (like getting poison oak all over). You will need to call the doctor if this occurs.
- 4) Tips:
  - -Be patient. It may take 2-3 months for the warts to respond.
  - -Keep it out of children's reach.
  - -Do not try to overuse! It may cause a severe reaction.
